SCHOLARSHIP

The award will be \$1,500, which may be used at the discretion of the recipient. The scholarship recipient will be recognized at the annual Awards Luncheon at the AAHE/AAHPERD convention and given the opportunity to present at a poster session. Application materials must be received by December 1. The recipient will be notified in February.

ELIGIBILITY

The award is open to a doctoral level student who is currently enrolled in a health education program in the United States or a U.S. territory. To be eligible to apply, you must be an AAHE member and a graduate student at an accredited college/university (not a school of public health) in a doctoral level course of study leading to preparing you to develop, implement and/or evaluate health education programs for children and youth. You must also have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 in graduate courses.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. The completed application form must be received by December 1 of each year. All application materials must be submitted simultaneously in a single envelope.
2. The application and accompanying documents must be typed, single-spaced, with 12-point font. Follow the format as advised.
3. All applications must be accompanied by:
 - a. A current resume or curriculum vitae. Use the following categories, presenting the material in reverse chronological order where applicable.
 1. Personal information
 2. Current program and institution
 3. Degrees earned, names of institutions and year of graduation
 4. Employment experience and dates of employment
 5. Professional presentations: titles, dates and locations of presentations
 6. Professional publications
 7. Professional memberships
 8. Awards
 9. Professional committee involvement
 10. Voluntary community service activities
 11. Any other extra-curricular or professional activities
 - b. A transcript from the institution granting the most recent degree, any coursework that fulfills requirements for the current doctoral degree program or verification of admittance to a doctoral program.
 - c. A narrative two-part statement that includes your professional goals and explanation of how your dissertation topic will contribute to the health of children and youth. *The maximum length for this narrative is five (5) double-spaced pages. Include sub-titles for each of the areas.*
 - d. Two (2) letters of recommendation from professional individuals, addressing academic status, leadership potential, and career commitment. One (1) of the letters must be from the applicant's advisor or a faculty member of the department where the applicant is enrolled.

CRITERIA

1. Academic achievement
2. Applicant's potential for advancing the health of children and youth
3. Professional goals
4. Caliber of the documents
